

Best Practices for New Installations of Kirsch® Automation

All Automation projects are unique. It is recommended that the designer and installer consult prior to installation to understand all expectations.

REMOTE

1. Pair* all Kirsch Automation Remote Modules to a single Source Remote Module to create a Automation Network.
**It is required to always pair two or more remotes on the same project, with or without a Hub*
2. Pair all Automation Repeaters* to a Remote Module on the Automation Network.
**Repeaters can be used on remote only projects to enhance the RF signal from the remote to the shades*
3. Install one room of shades at a time and as you install those shades power them up only one room at a time.
– *Use the Manual Control Button located on the headrail to test functionality*
4. Program the first room of shades to the corresponding Remote Module. Create a Duplicate Remote* if needed.
**Duplicating remotes is different than pairing remotes to a Automation network*

APP & HUB

5. Connect the Automation Hub to a Wi-Fi router.
If you are using:
 - *Installer's router: Connect via Ethernet cable*
 - *Homeowner's router: Connect via Wi-Fi*
 - * Know which router is available prior to installation.*
6. Confirm your mobile device is connected to the proper wireless network. Launch the Automation App.
7. Follow the steps listed in the Automation App to setup the Automation Hub.
 - *Connect to Hub*
 - *Name the Hub (according to consumer)*
 - *Join the Automation Network:*
 - *With Remote*
 - *I don't have a Remote (use the Hub to create Network)*
8. Discover shades one room at a time using the Automation App.
 - *For larger projects, it is a best practice to begin this step in conjunction with the remote programming process*
 - *When discovering shades in additional rooms, select "Shades" from the menu screen and press Discover*
9. After discovering shades in the first room of the home, create a Room within the Automation App.
 - *Select the discovered shades to add to corresponding App Room*
Here's a Tip! For larger projects, build all App Rooms during set up and prior to discovery. All shades discovered using the one room at a time process can be selected to add to the App Room in one step.
